INTRODUCTION

This manual covers the operator accessible service mode features, options (also called “modes”) settings and diagnostic/data logs.

The FLEX controller hardware utilizes a 3.5 inch screen, as a key feature visible from the outside of the vending machine. Optional hardware features include a 10” iCart touch screen.

SERVICE MODE

Use **Service Mode** to program and change settings. Use the keypad as an input device and watch the display for information while performing Service Mode functions.

SERVICE MODE BUTTON

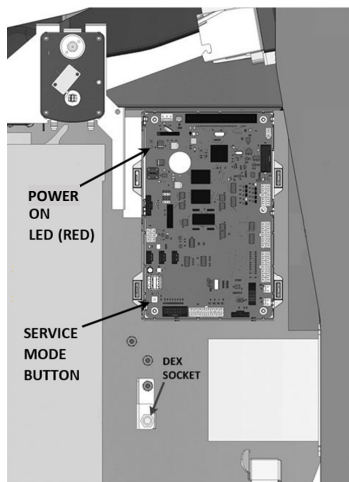


Figure 1 – Service Mode Button

To enter **Service Mode**, press the **Service Mode Button** located in the lower left hand corner of the control board. See figure1. To exit Service Mode, press the Service Mode Button again or press the key 3 times.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

If no key is pressed for approximately 1 minute while in **Service Mode**, the controller will automatically return to **Sales Mode**.

KEYPAD

To program the vendor, use the buttons on the keypad to navigate as directed in the instructions below.

Buttons 2, 8, 4, 6, # and * are used to move between the various modes, menus and sub-menus; 2=Move Up; 8=Move Down, 4=Move Left; 6=Move Right; #=Enter; *=Go Back/Escape

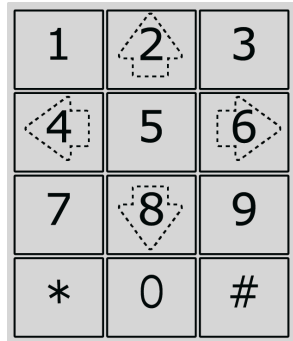
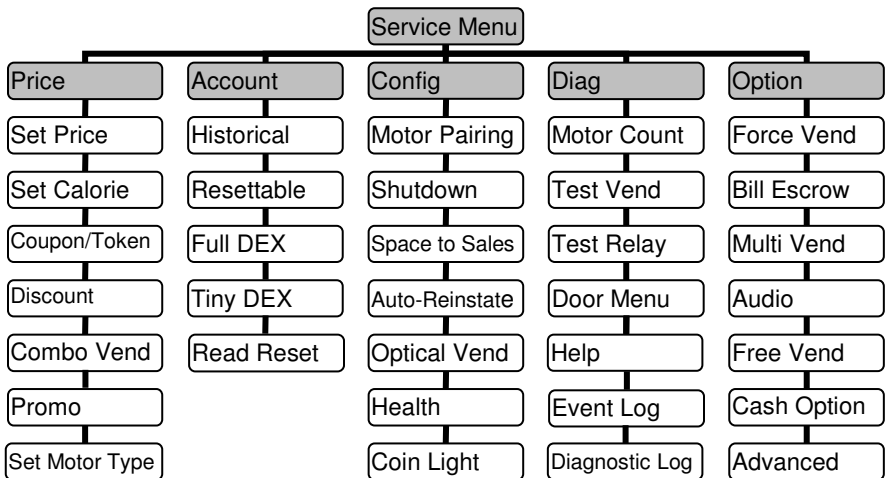


Figure 2 - Keypad

Important Note: The FLEX controller does not utilize a **TUBE FILL MODE**; the controller uses the tube amounts that are reported by the coin changer.

PRICE MENU

The **Set Price** menu allows three (3) methods for assigning prices:

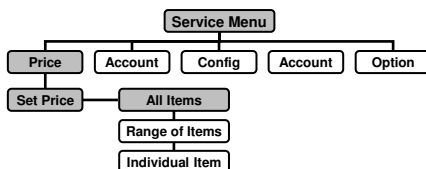
- ALL ITEMS.
- RANGE OF ITEMS.
- INDIVIDUAL ITEM


The maximum price that can be set is \$655.35.

SET PRICE ALL ITEMS

This menu allows you to set the selection price of every item in the machine at the same time.

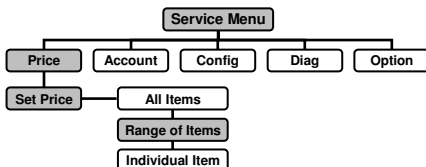
Time Saving Tip: Use the all items option to set the most common price in the machine; then go back and set the different price of each item or row.

This menu allows you to set multiple items to vend for one unassigned selection number and price.

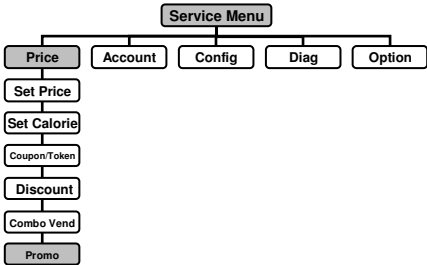

ACCOUNTING MENU

Use this menu to gain access to menus that display or reset data for various types of cash and vend totals. Counters can be viewed by individual items, rows or as the whole machine.

Historical totals: These are the counts since the initialization of the machine. They cannot be reset.

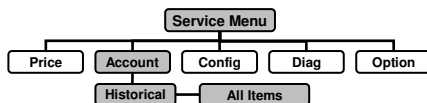
Resettable totals: These are totals since the last reset. These can be reset at any time.


IMPORTANT NOTE: Clearing by item or range will only clear the item or range entered.

VIEW HISTORICAL ALL ITEMS

This menu displays the historical total sales value and total vend count for the entire machine.

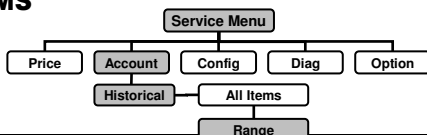
